Vatican Prefect for Eastern Churches thanks Bishop Campbell for providing Preston's Cathedral for Syro-Malabars in Britain

Cardinal Leonardo Sandri, the Vatican's Prefect of the Congregation for Eastern Churches, has written to Bishop Michael Campbell (the letter is overleaf) to personally thank him and the Diocese of Lancaster for providing the new Syro-Malabar Eparchy for Great Britain with their new cathedral church of St Alphonsa – formerly St Ignatius' Church, Preston.

The letter (dated 15 September 2016) from the Cardinal comes just before the weekend's momentous and historic episcopal ordination of Mar Joseph Srampickal - the new Eparch (Bishop) - for the Syro-Malabars in Great Britain at Deepdale (Preston North End's Football stadium) and the dedication of the new Cathedral itself in central Preston.

The Rt Rev Michael G Campbell OSA, Bishop of Lancaster said:

"I am absolutely delighted that our Holy Father Pope Francis established the new Eparchy for the Syro-Malabar Faithful in Great Britain on 28 July so as to provide the necessary Church leadership, stability and strength for the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church to bear witness to Jesus Christ in these lands going forward. We stand by and pray for Bishop-Elect Mar Joseph Srampickal and his clergy and people in the days, months and years ahead."

The Bishop continued:

"I am aware that, as the Eparchy begins its infancy, it will require the continued support of the Diocese and indeed all the Catholic dioceses of England, Wales and Scotland and surely this will be forthcoming in so many ways. For us in Lancaster, we are so pleased to have been able to provide the new Eparchy with its new beautiful Cathedral church - St Alphonsa - **Preston's first - and only - Cathedral.**"
