KNIGHTS OF ST COLUMBA NATIVITY SCENE PAINTING COMPETITION <u>2021/2022.</u>

The 2019/20 Nativity Scene Painting Competition is launched in September 2021. Provincial winning entries are to arrive at Head Office no later than Friday 4^h February 2022.

As in previous years the competition will be open to two separate Primary age groups, i.e.:

England/Wales School Year Groups; Reception, 1 & 2, (4 to 7 years of age). Scotland School Year Groups; P1, P2 & P3 (4 to 7 years of age).

England/Wales School Year Groups: 3, 4, 5 & 6. (7 to 11 years of age) Scotland School Year Groups; P4, P6 & P7 (7 to 11 years of age).

Note: The School Year Groupings will be the prime categorisation factor.

THEME GUIDE

1) Nativity Scene of our Lord

2) Write Bible chapter and <u>Verse</u> that best relates to your drawing

The competitor's entries will be of their own free hand drawing and colouring production; the use of pre prepared tracings should be discouraged. The entries are to be submitted sized either <u>A4 or A3</u> on paper or card of a quality and colour of the entrant's choice. **The Bible Chapter and Verse can be written on the painting, on the reverse or on attachment.**

The following information should be shown legibly on the reverse of each entry:

Name of entrant. Age of entrant. Date of birth of entrant. School Year Group. Name and full address of school, parish or group attended, (the latter might be say a Brownie or Cub Group etc). **Sponsoring Province and/or Council.**

Entries will, in the first instance, be judged at local Council level, winning entries forwarded to Province for judging at Provincial level. ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed age group winners from each Province is to be forwarded to Head Office for entry into the final National round of judging.

Provinces and Councils are advised to set their programmes to ensure that winning entries from all competing Councils are entered for Provincial adjudication, and that winning Provincial entries are forwarded to Head Office to arrive no later than Friday 4th February 2022 for final adjudication. The awards after final adjudication will be:

England/Wales School Year Groups; Reception, 1 & 2, (4 – 5 to 7 years of age). Scotland School Year Groups; P1, P2 & P3 (4 to 7 years of age).

Winner 1 st Place:	Cash Prize of 30:00. Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight. Winners Trophy to keep.
2 nd Place:	Cash Prize of £20:00. Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.
3 rd Place:	Cash Prize of £15:00. Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.

A cash award of £150:00 will be presented to the school or group of which the winner is a pupil or member.

Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the winners school or group

England/Wales School Year Groups: 3, 4, 5 & 6. (7 to 11 years of age) Scotland School Year Groups; P4, P6 & P7 (7 to 11 years of age).

Winner 1 st Place:	Cash Prize of 30:00. Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.
	Winners Trophy to keep.
2 nd Place:	Cash Prize of £20:00.
	Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.
3 rd Place:	Cash Prize of £15:00.
	Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight.

A cash award of £150:00 will be presented to the school or group of which the winner is a pupil or member.

Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the winners school or group

Overall Winner, i.e. the better of the Winning Entries from Groups 1 & 2 combined. Overall Winner to be presented with: Certificate signed by the Supreme Knight will also be presented to the Overall winner

The Columba Rouse Trophy which will be retained for approximately one Year by the Overall Winners Province.

Date and venue of national awards presentations will be announced at a later date.
